## **USER'S GUIDE**

## **WP Instant Decor+ Documentation**

**WP Instant Decor+** is a plugin designed to spice up your web pages by instantly adding various decorations and special effects. Brighten up your pages and make it more lively and engaging especially it is themed just in time for the holiday season.

This plugin comes with a lite version and lacks the following features: **Video**, **Note** and **Box Decoration**.


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## How to Use WP Instant Decor+


This guide assumes that you have already logged in to your WordPress admin area and that you have already installed and activated **WP Instant Decor+**.

Note that in order for this to work, you will have to meet the prerequisite which is, an existing page/post or create a new one and save as draft. Once that has been met, view the live page from the frontend or preview for page/post that has been saved as draft. Additional requirement would be to make sure that the WordPress toolbar has been enabled. If you are unsure, simply navigate from the WordPress dashboard to **Users -> Your Profile**. Ensure that the checkbox labeled **Show Toolbar when viewing site** has been checked.



## Adding and Managing Decorations to Pages/Posts

1. To begin styling your pages/posts with WP Instant Decor+, open the page/post on the frontend as admin or if the page/post is still in draft more, click preview from the editor.
2. Once you are at the frontend, on the top most part where the WordPress toolbar is located, hover **Add Page Decorator**.



3. Select the decoration you would like to add to the page. Each decoration has its own corresponding option.


- **Image.** Adds an image from the default list or the media library that includes not just the regular static images but moving graphics as well.
  1. When the **Image** decoration is selected, automatically a window will display containing all the list of images that are available as default and those that have been uploaded on the media library. Select one.
  2. Once an image is selected, it will be brought down to the bottom most part of the page by default.
  3. Hover on the image to display the options. Clicking and dragging the direction arrows allow you to drag the image to the desired position on the page. Clicking the pen icon enables you to configure display settings of the image.



- **Style**
  - **Opacity.** Determines the transparency of the image. Enter a decimal number between 0 to 1 where 0 makes the image very transparent and 1 100% visible.


- **Width.** Enter a number that corresponds the width of the image in pixels. The system will automatically adjust the aspect ratio of the image based on the provided value so that it maintains the quality of the image. Leaving the field empty will default to its original width.
- **Height.** Enter a number that corresponds the height of the image in pixels. The system will automatically adjust the aspect ratio of the image based on the provided value so that it maintains the quality of the image. Leaving the field empty will default to its original height.
- **Position**
  - **Top.** Defines the location of the image relative to its original position from the top. Enter a value on this field to set the image on the desired position.
  - **Left.** Defines the location of the image relative to its original position from the left. Enter a value on this field to set the image on the desired position.
  - **Helper.** Use this dropdown to select from the pre-defined positions.
  - **Z-Index.** Enter a numerical value that should be a whole number to define the position of the image with respect to the current elements on the page. The higher the value, the higher is the page's regard to it as the priority to be displayed preceding all elements.
- **Duration.**
  - **Date Start.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the image shall be shown.
  - **Date End.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the image shall cease to be displayed.

4. Once all desired settings are in place. Click the **Save Change** button.
  5. To delete the image, click the red **Delete** button.
- **Snow Effect.** Adds a snow effect on the background on the page.
    1. When the **Snow Effect** has been selected, a popup window will prompt you to customize the snow effect that will be displayed on the page.

- **Effect Type.** Select what type of snow effect you would like to utilize from the predefined list available on the dropdown.
  - **Color.** Select from the background the color you would like to display the bits of snow effect on the page.
2. To manage options for the snow effect, click the **Manage Snow Effect** panel located by default on the leftmost part of the page just below the WordPress toolbar.



3. Click the pen icon to make changes on the snow effect.
    - **Style**
      - **Type.** The type of snow effect you wish to replace the currently running style.
      - **Color.** The color of the snow effect bits shown on the page.
    - **Duration.**
      - **Date Start.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the snow effect starts falling.
      - **Date End.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the snow effect will cease to display.
  4. Once you have made the necessary changes on the snow effect, click the **Save Change** button.
  5. Otherwise, click the **Delete** button to remove the decoration.
- **Video.** Lets you add a video on the page. Note that this option is not available on the lite version of the plugin.
    1. Once the **Video** decoration has been selected, a popup window will appear and will prompt you with details to display the desired video decoration on the page.



ADD VIDEO



- **Video ID.** The video ID of the youtube video you would like to display on the page.




- **Autoplay.** Determines whether you would like the video to play automatically when the page loads.
  - **Width.** Defines the width of the video in pixels.
  - **Height.** Defines the height of the video in pixels.
2. Once you are through with the necessary settings, click **Add Video.**
  3. To update the video, hover your cursor on the video. Click the directional icon to drag the video on any position desired on the page. Click the pen icon to make changes on the settings of the video.
    - **Video**
      - **Video ID.** Enter the video ID of a different video you would like to replace the current one with.
      - **Autoplay.** Determines whether the video starts playing automatically when the new video loads on the page.
    - **Style**

- **Opacity.** Determines how transparent the video is on the page. Enter a decimal number between 0 to 1 where 0 is the most transparent and 1 making the video 100% visible.
- **Width.** Defines the width of the video in pixels.
- **Height.** Defines the height of the video in pixels.
- **Position**
  - **Top.** Enter a number that will define the position of the video relative to its original top position in pixels.
  - **Left.** Enter a number that will define the position of the video relative to its original position from the left side of the page position in pixels.
  - **Helper.** Select from the dropdown predefined positions for the video.
  - **Z-Index.** Enter a numerical value that should be a whole number to define the position of the video with respect to the current elements on the page. The higher the value, the higher is the page's regard to it as the priority to be displayed preceding all elements.
- **Duration.**
  - **Date Start.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the video shall be shown.
  - **Date End.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the video shall cease to be displayed.

4. Once all desired settings are in place. Click the **Save Change** button.

5. To delete the video, click the red **Delete** button.

- **Note.** Allows you to add a note-like content on the page. This decoration is not available on the lite version of the plugin.
  1. From the plugin's menu item on the WordPress toolbar click **Note**. This should display a popup window similar to the following image.

ADD NOTE

- **Content.** Enter the content of the note you would like to display on the page. HTML tags are not allowed.
  - **Width.** Defines the width of the note in pixels.
  - **Height.** Defines the height of the note in pixels.
2. Click **Add Note** to add the note to the page.
  3. To manage the note, hover on the recently added note and drag the directional button to reposition the note to any part of the page. To edit and update the note's settings, click the pen icon.
    - **Content.** Update the note with the new content you desire to replace the current one.
    - **Style**
      - **Opacity.** Determines how transparent the note is on the page. Enter a decimal number between 0 to 1 where 0 is the most

transparent and 1 making the note 100% visible.

- **Width.** Defines the width of the note in pixels.
- **Height.** Defines the height of the note in pixels.
- **Background Color.** Use the built-in color picker to define the background color of the note.
- **Color.** Use the color picker to determine the color of the texts.
- **Border.** Adds a border around the note. On the input field enter how thick you would like the border to be in pixels. Next, define the color of the border by clicking the color picker just beside the input field.


- **Position**

- **Top.** Enter a number that will define the position of the note relative to its original top position in pixels.
- **Left.** Enter a number that will define the position of the note relative to its original position from the left side of the page in pixels.
- **Helper.** Select from the dropdown predefined positions you would like to apply to the note.
- **Z-Index.** Enter a numerical value that should be a whole number to define the position of the note with respect to the current elements on the page. The higher the value, the higher is the page's regard to it as the priority to be displayed preceding all elements.

- **Duration.**

- **Date Start.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the note shall be shown.
- **Date End.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the note shall cease to be displayed.

4. Once you have reviewed and finalized the settings of the note, click the **Save Change** button to update the note with the new configurations.
  5. Click the **Delete** button if you wish to remove it on the page.
- **Box.** Allows you to add a box on the page. It is somehow similar to note except that it has more options and more customizable.
    1. To add a **Box** decoration on the page, hover your cursor over the plugin's menu item from the WordPress toolbar and select **Box**. A window like the following image should be displayed.

**ADD BOX**

- **Title.** Enter contents that would serve as the heading of the box.

- **Content.** Supply this field with the information you would like to displayed on the box.
  - **Button Label.** Enter the text you would like to display on the button.
  - **Button URL.** Enter the complete URL of the page you would like to redirect the user once the button has been clicked.
  - **Width.** Define the width of the box in pixels.
  - **Height.** Define the height of the box in pixels.
2. Once you are through with the general information of the box, click the **Add Box** button.
  3. To make changes on the box, hover your cursor over it and drag the directional icon to reposition the box on the desired location on the page. Click the pen icon if you would like to make changes on the current settings.
    - **Content.**
      - **Title.** Replace with a new title you would like instead of the current one.
      - **Content.** Replace the contents with new ones.
      - **Button Label.** Replaces the label of the button's current label.
      - **Button URL.** Update with the complete URL of a different page should you wish to replace the current one.
    - **Style**
      - **Opacity.** Determines how transparent the box would be on the page. Enter a decimal number between 0 to 1 where 0 is the most transparent and 1 making the note 100% visible.
      - **Width.** Updates the width of the box in pixels.
      - **Height.** Updates the height of the box in pixels.
      - **Background Color.** Use the built-in color picker to define the background color of the box.

- **Color.** Use the color picker to determine the color of the texts displayed on the box.
- **Border.** Adds a border around the box. On the input field enter how thick you would like the border to be in pixels. Next, define the color of the border by clicking the color picker just beside the input field.
- **Button Style.** From the dropdown, choose from the list of predefined options you would like to apply on the box' button.
- **Button Color.** Select from the list of predefined color schemes in the dropdown which one you would like to apply along with the button style.
- **Position**
  - **Top.** Enter a number that will define the position of the box relative to its original top position in pixels.
  - **Left.** Enter a number that will define the position of the box relative to its original position from the left side of the page in pixels.
  - **Helper.** Select from the dropdown's predefined positions you wish to apply to the box.
  - **Z-Index.** Enter a numerical value that should be a whole number to define the position of the box with respect to the current elements on the page. The higher the value, the higher is the page's regard to it as the priority to be displayed preceding all elements.
- **Duration.**
  - **Date Start.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the box shall be shown.
  - **Date End.** Click the field to define the date and time using the date and time picker when the box shall cease to be displayed.

4. Once you have reviewed and finalized the settings of the box, click the **Save Change** button to update the box with the new contents and configurations.
5. Click the **Delete** button if you wish to remove it on the page.
